To the WCRP Members:

The WCRP's 2017 Fiscal Year has come to a close, with the last payment paid, the last receivable received, and the financial position transitioning even further from a projection toward an actuality. As your President, Vice-President, and Secretary/Treasurer, we present to you this 2017 Annual Report.

The 2017 Fiscal Year saw a number of key successes, including an increase in our Net Position, an annual financial audit with zero findings, numerous dismissals and defense verdicts, enhanced loss control and risk management efforts, and a broadening of our training and education programs. 


