Claims and Risk Management News Impacting WCRP Members

Way to go, Clallam County!

With a phenomenal score of 100%, the Clallam County jail will be the first county jail in the State to receive official accreditation from the **Washington Association of Sheriffs and Police Chiefs (WASPC)** when it is formally voted on at WASPC's board meeting this month. 148 standards are examined by a committee made up of state-wide jail and law enforcement professionals, looking at various functions and policies. The County has made jail operations a success and safety a priority, with the use of a great staff and various resources, including Lexipol.

With jail liability still being a key focus for the WCRP, it's great to see our member counties making these efforts and receiving this recognition. We look forward to seeing more WCRP members achieving WASPC accreditation. Great work, Clallam County!!

New Paid Sick Leave Requirements Effective Soon

We mentioned this in a past issue and we're bugging you again about it. The Department of Labor & Industries is releasing the WACs addressing the new paid sick leave law. You can read all about it, or feel free to call with questions. Remember, your practice should follow the law, regardless of what your written policy says, so get your written policies updated. If your policy change is pending, the law should guide your practice and your policies should be written to follow.

A WCRP Scholarship was offered to member counties to attend a webinar tomorrow, November 8th, on this subject (see below). The deadline to register has passed, but we anticipate additional webinars and information becoming available again soon.

To Waive or Not to Waive

Under Washington's Industrial Insurance Act (<u>Title 51</u>), employees who receive worker's compensation benefits cannot sue their employer, short of specific exceptions. However, Title 51 does not prevent injured workers from collecting from both worker's compensation and also seeking compensation from a third party. That third-party could be the county.

If your county signs a contract with a contractor and the contractor agrees to indemnify your county but does not stipulate that their Title 51 immunity is waived, the County could end up being sued by the contractor's employee. When you ask the contractor to indemnify you, the contractor may say "sorry, but we're immune under Title 51". For this reason, WCRP recommends requiring the contractor to waive Title 51 RCW immunity when possible. Conversely, beware of those asking the county to waive its own immunity, or you could be involved when your own employee sues a third-party, whom you have agreed to defend and/or indemnify.
