**OVERVIEW:** With increased civil unrest and the potential for workplace violence, employees need to be aware of their surroundings and form a plan of action now more than ever. Participants of this 4-part series will come away with a better understanding of how certain situations trigger a reaction or "gut instinct" and what that instinct is trying to tell you. Jesus will teach practical skills to help participants actively practice situational awareness and identify some of the pre-cursors of violence. Jesus will then dive into essential skills to verbally de-escalate tense situations, and will also identify when fleeing the situation is the best and safest option.
